

Green Volunteer Training Programme

The Kerala School Kalolsavam is an annual event organized by the Government of Kerala, featuring various art competitions for high school and higher secondary school students across the state. The 62nd edition of the Kerala School Kalolsavam was held in Kollam district. A key feature of this edition was the implementation of the Green Protocol, and a dedicated committee was appointed to ensure strict adherence to this protocol.

The Green Protocol committee approached our volunteers to assist in this initiative. To prepare for their roles, volunteers and teachers underwent proper training to lead the activities of the Green Protocol committee during the Arts Festival. The training program, titled "Haritha Kalolsavam 2024," was held on 3rd January 2024 at 2 p.m. in the Bishop Jerome Auditorium, Fatima Mata National College, Kollam. The event was organized under the leadership of the Green Protocol Committee and the District Sanitation Mission.

Teachers and volunteers from various schools and colleges across Kollam district attended the training session, including our own volunteers and Program Officers. The training was led by Thodiyoor Radhakrishnan, who provided guidance on how to minimize plastic usage during the Arts Festival and how to transform the event into a Green Arts Festival. The session also covered the various types of waste and how to properly dispose of them in designated areas. Furthermore, the committee instructed how to guide attendees during the festival to ensure compliance with the Green Protocol.

At the conclusion of the meeting, all volunteers were added to the Green Volunteer WhatsApp group, and ID cards for Green Volunteers were distributed to the Program Officers.

By participating in this training program, the volunteers gained a deeper understanding of how to effectively perform their duties as Green Volunteers. The training not only equipped them with the necessary skills but also highlighted the importance of their role in promoting environmental sustainability at the Arts Festival.
