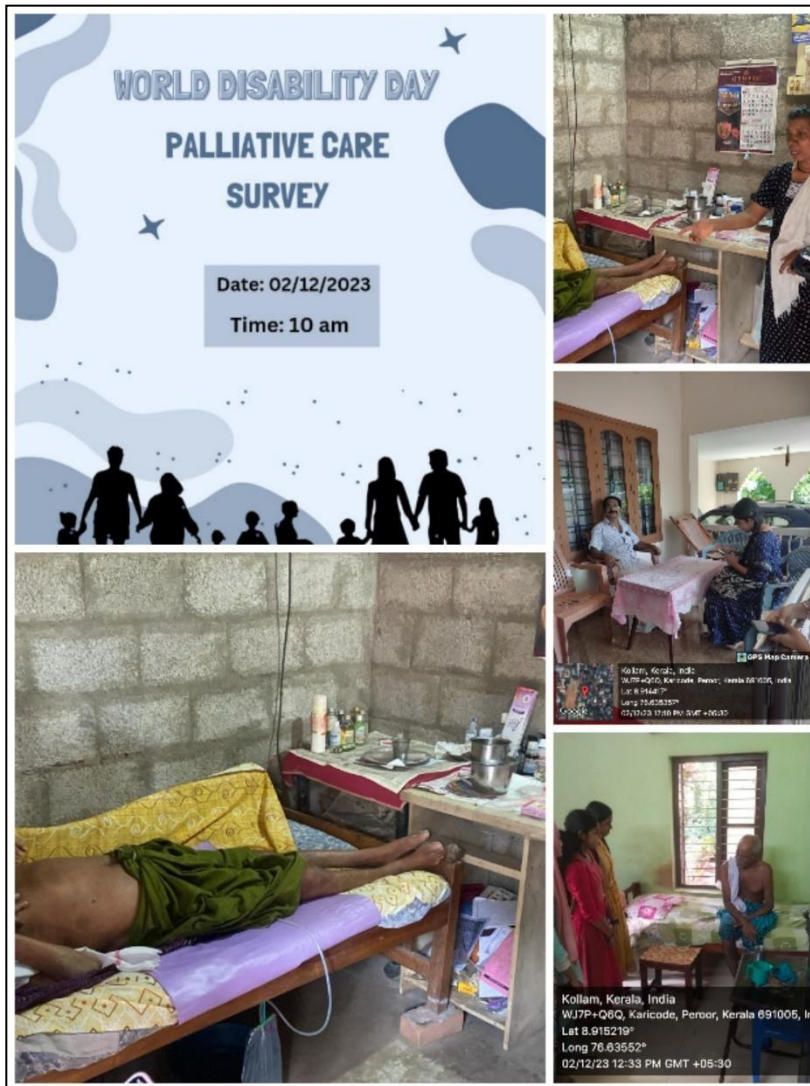


# PALLIATIVE CARE SURVEY
