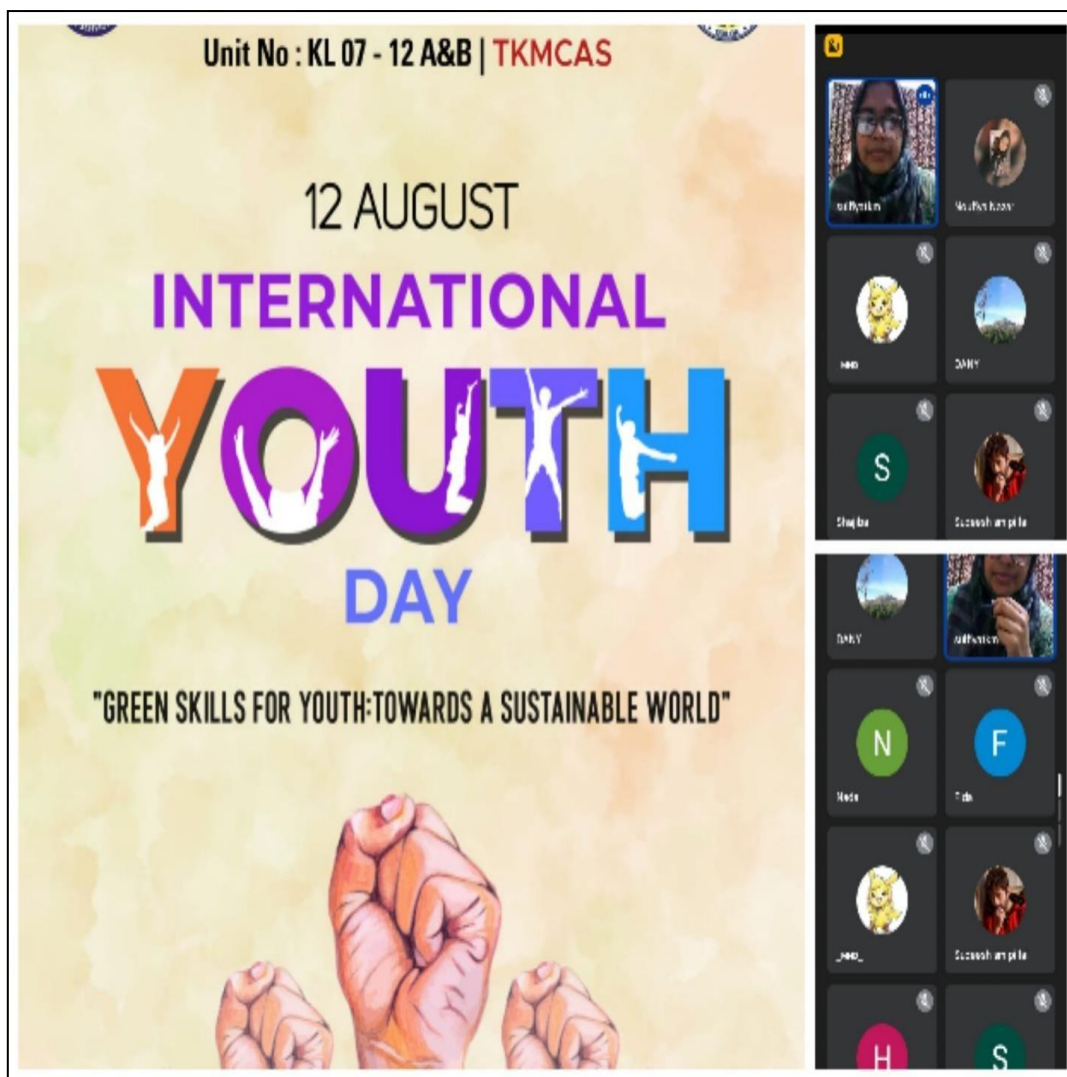


## Green Skills for Youth: Towards a Sustainable World
