


## Debate on “Is Indian Democracy Successful?”

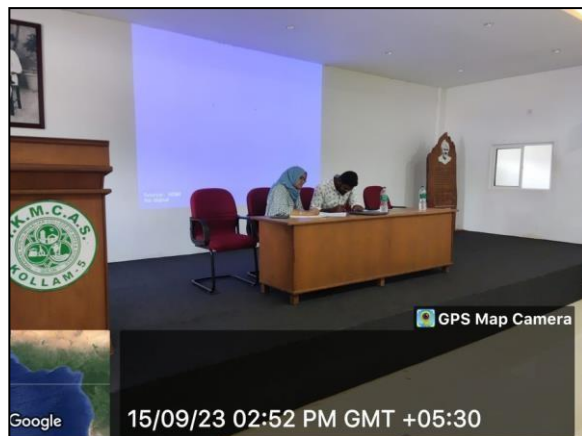
