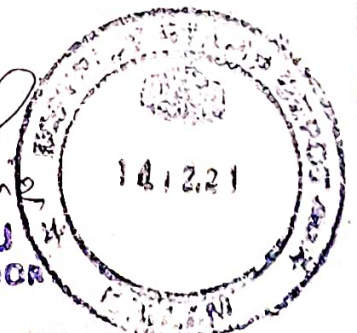

Sanatana Dharma College, Alappuzha, the oldest affiliated Arts and Science College under the University of Kerala managed by Sanatana Dharma Vidyasala hereinafter referred to as SDC, of the SECOND PART, for the purpose of exchange of faculty, staff and students.

The aforesaid institutes are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

Preamble

WHEREAS, TKMCAS and SDC have many areas of common interest in arts, science and commerce, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, conservation of nature, education, and research.

NOW THEREFORE, TKMCAS and SDC have decided to enter into this MoU of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutes set out in the following sections.

Objectives

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutes shall seek to promote knowledge transfer by way of:

Faculty exchange

- The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutes.
- Collaboration in teaching, research, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- The exchange of academic materials and publications,
- Conducting lectures/seminars/webinars/symposia/conferences/workshops on topics of mutual interest.

Training programmes

- To transfer the know-how developed at the Centre for Research on Aquatic Resources, S. D. College to produce value added products from the weed plant Water Hyacinth (*Eichhornia crassipes*) to the students of TKMCAS.
- Any other mutually beneficial technologies developed at the respective institutes.

TKMCAS and SDC agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide the activity identified above will be agreed upon by the two institutes. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.


Coordination

Each institute shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of TKMCAS, and a programme coordinator from the side of SDC, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutes.

Validity

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of Two (2) Years commencing from effective date. Institutes may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review. Either institute may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of Three (3) Months in advance to the other institute. Once terminated, neither TKMCAS nor SDC will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institute may suffer. However, TKMCAS and SDC will ensure that the provisions of this MoU shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes. Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this MoU must adhere to the law of the host countries and rules and regulations of the institutes. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This MoU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration. In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation,
