(i) The Candidate is being granted the service of scribe & compensatory time of 20 minute per hour for answering each paper for all upcoming regular & supplementary degree exams during the course period. The Principal/Chief Superintendent is authorised to appoint a suitable scribe for the candidate who is neither an employee of the college nor interested in the candidate. Special care shall be taken to ensure that the scribe appointed does not have educational qualification higher than that of the candidate. The remuneration to the scribe shall be paid by the Principal / Chief Superintendent at the rate of ₹ 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Fifty only) per paper and claim the amount in separate bills immediately after the examination, vide U.O read as (1) above.

(ii) The candidate is granted gracemarks of 25% of the total marks in the theory examinations attended by the candidate provided he secures a minimum of 10% in the theory examinations subject to the condition limited to attain a maximum of 60% marks for each subject ie, the total of ESA marks secured and the grace marks should not exceed 60% of the maximum ESA marks of the subject, subject to all other stipulations, vide U.O read as (2) above from his first semester regular exam onwards during the course period. The candidate shall not be considered for ranking in this programme.
