

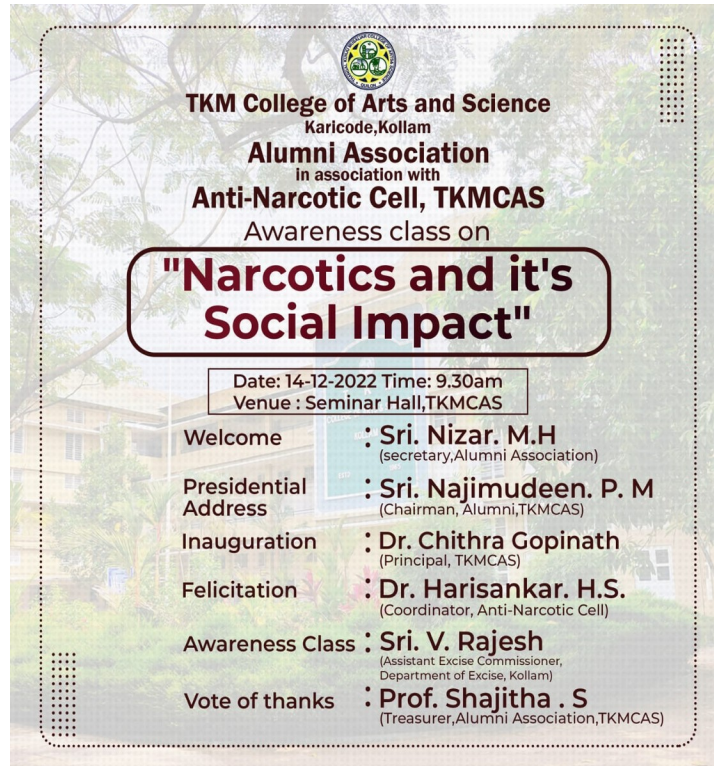

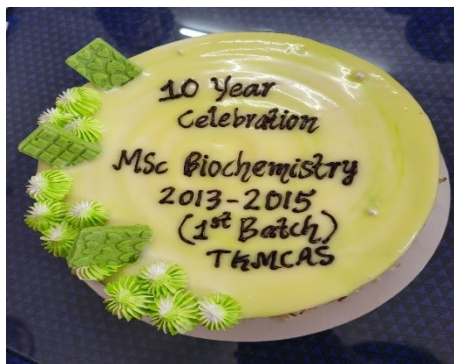

## BYE-LAWS

### **I. Name**

The name of the association shall be 'Forum of Retired teachers', TKM College of Arts & Science, Kollam.

### **II. Objectives**

1. to maintain relationship with the retired teachers and their families.
2. to keep the contact alive with the college and the management.
3. to extend financial assistance to the deserving students of the college.

### **III. Membership**

The retired teachers of the college are members of the forum and a contribution of Rs. 2000/- is expected from them towards the "Education Fund".

### **IV. The General Body**

1. The general body shall consist of all members of the forum. The general management of the forum shall be vested with the executive committee of 21 members elected by the general body.

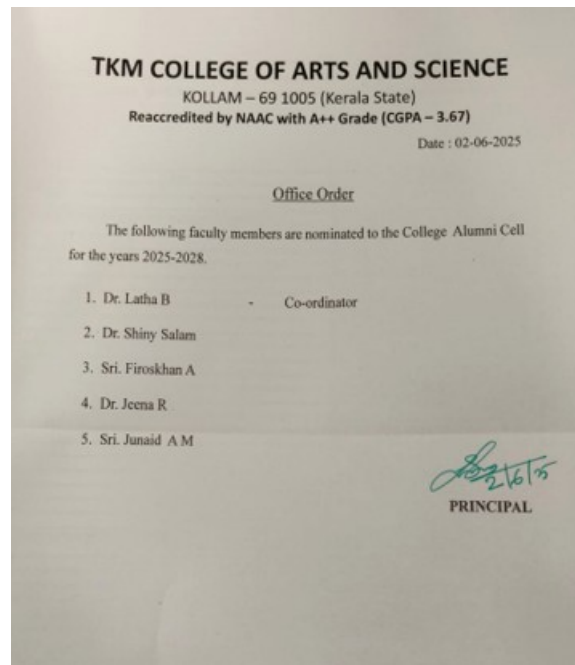

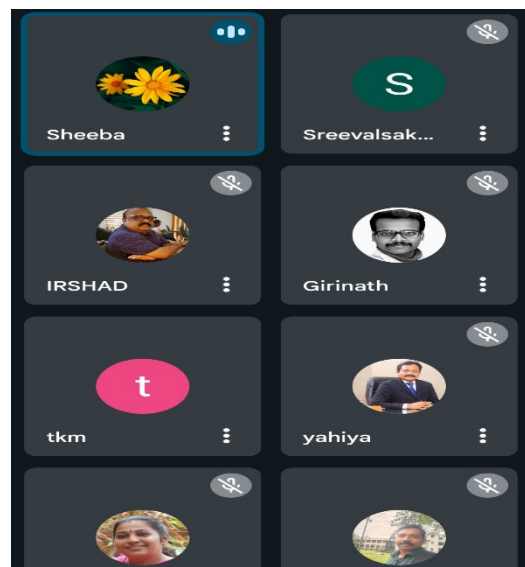
